Glossary of Terms

EXS – expected standard; this is the standard to which the Department for Education expect every child to attain

GDS – greater depth; this is a standard above the expected standard.

TA – teacher assessment; some results are based on test results, some are based on teachers using all available information to form a judgement and some are based on a combination of tests and teacher assessments

MTC – multiplication timestables check; this is an electronic test administered in Year 4. There is no pass mark so we have published the percentage of children achieving full marks.
