Help your child practice talking about these photographs so they can stand up and talk to the class about them.

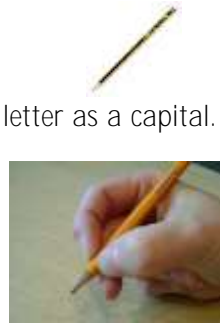


### Literacy

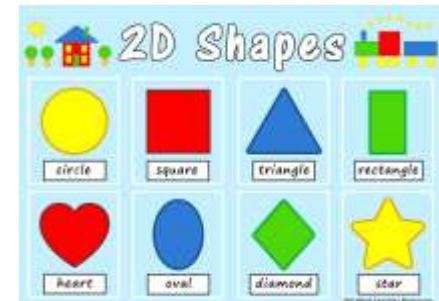
