

School Meals & Breakfast Club - Charges from September 2025

We would like to advise that from Wednesday 3rd September 2025 there will be a price increase to the cost of breakfast club and school meals. The current price for breakfast club is £1.50 per day, this will rise to £2.00 per day, to ensure all children attending continue to receive a healthy breakfast and the best supervision before they start the school day.

School meals will also increase to £2.60 per day for a nutritionally balanced two-course meal would still proves excellent value for money. We continue to work closely with LCC who provide the catering service and have taken their advice with the price increase but still remained lower than their recommended charge per meal. They continue to offer an exciting and varied range of meals which are both healthy and nutritious. All of the menus are developed in line with the nutritional standards which meets the government food standards and gives value for money.

There will be no impact for KS1 children who receive the government funded Universal Infant Free School meal offer, or our students in receipt of Free School Meals.

For parents who pay for school meals we would like to remind you that it may be worth making an application for Free School Meals

Forest Pre-School & Nursery

This week we have been revising for Grammar and spelling. In Mathis we have continued to look at shapes and angles as well as a range of reasoning questions. Next week is a 4 day week and the final school week before SATs.

Action

Please encourage your child to complete their work and look at past SATs paper to help them with their revision. It is important your child makes the most of their weekends to revise and refresh their memory so they are feeling prepared and confident. Only 4 school days left till SATs or 11 days if we count the days we are home. Make each and every day count...
