# English

We will be reading the book "Outlaw" by Michael Murpurgo. A book about Robin Hood. We will use this to help write balanced arguments, historical fiction and fact files.

# Maths

This term, we will focussing on Place Value, and the four operations.
We will learning about numbers up to 1 million and start to learn complex mathematical strategies.

## Science

This term's science, is all about materials. Within this topic, we will look at dissolving and sieving.

We will learn which substances are soluble, magnetic or conduct electricity.
