### Key Messages...

P.E. every Friday. Century Tech to be used for homework. Read a minimum of 3-times a week.

#### English

We will be reading the book "Outlaw" by Michael Murpurgo. A book about Robin Hood. We will use this to help write balanced arguments, historical fiction and fact files.

#### Maths

This term, we will focussing on Place Value, and the four operations. We will learning about numbers up to 1 million and start to learn complex mathematical strategies.

#### Science

This term's science, is all about materials. Within this topic, we will look at dissolving and sieving. We will learn which substances are soluble, magnetic or conduct electricity.

#### RE

In RE, we will be diving in the depths of Holy Books. We will look at different Holy books from Christianity, Islam, Judaism and Hinduism.

#### Art

In Art, we will study the life and work of David Hackney. We will be inspired to create artwork like him using different mediums including digital and acrylics

#### History

The Romans left, the country is undefended. Was inviting some Anglo-Saxon warriors to help fight a tribe from Pictland the right thing to do? That's what we will find out!.

#### Geography

How many different countries do you know? Can you label them on a map? What about the latitude and longitude location of a place? We will be learning about all of this.

#### MFL

In French, we will learn how to say different sports in French and then we will use our opinions to explain which sport is our favourite or which we sport we don't like.

#### Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at the world of make-believe. When to know if posts or emails are fake. How to identify it and how to report it.

#### PE

In PE, we are looking at new sport for the children, Handball. It has a close link to football but with different rules. We will then start to explore Victorian dance in Autumn 2.

#### DT

In DT, we will exploring the world of Rockets. The children will learn how rockets move and the designs that help them go to space.

#### Music

Our topic for music will be Music Tech. We study the differences in pitch, dynamics, diction and compose rhythmic patterns.

#### PSHE

In PSHE, we will be looking at what mental health is, being kind to one another and having a healthy lifestyle through physical exercise and eating.

#### Century Tech

Century Tech is an online learning tool which allows children to help learn topics within subject which they have struggled with or have missed in school. It provides lessons and questions to help their understanding.

This homework overview aims to give you some ideas of how to keep on learning at home. There are challenges to complete for each of the subjects studied in class, or some of the challenges might revisit prior learning. ### Computing

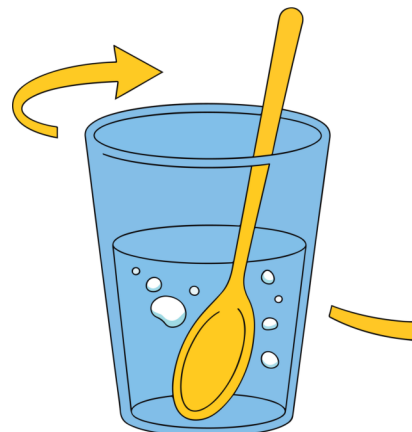
How safe are you online? Explore all your apps and devices.
