






Autumn Term Curriculum Overview Year 4

English

We will be reading Captain
Underpants, The Trapper, Rain
Rain, Wave me Goodbye, The
Great Plague and The Evacuee.
This term will focus on writing
stories with fantasy settings and
with issues and dilemmas. We will
have different grammar focuses
weekly whilst also focusing on
handwriting and spellings in our
English lessons. Spellings will be
taught daily in school.

Maths

Planners will need

In maths this term we will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction, measurement and finally multiplication and division.

Alongside this we will also be practising our timestables.



Science

In Science, we will be looking at electricity which comes under our physics topics. Here we will look at basic parts of an electrical circuit and build these in school.

In this unit, we will also look at electrical conductors and insulators and the similarities and differences between these.

RE

In RE we will be looking at how Christians believe Jesus shows Power and Authority in lots of different bible stories. We will also focusing on the symbolism of light linked with Christmas. During our lessons, children will explore the meaning of metaphors linked to light. There will also be links to other beliefs such as a Judaism and the Festival of Hanukkah.

Art

Our focus will be on architectural drawing this term looking at famous architects and their own inspiration. We will be looking at the work of famous architects Zaha Hadid and Norman Foster.

History

In our local history unit, we will being looking at the impact of the industrial revolution on Blackburn.




Geography

In Geography, we will be comparing settlements in Africa and Europe and the importance of landmarks around them. We will be looking at the uses of the River Nile and how people in Cairo used this physical resource.



Languages

In French we will be learning how to say different fruits in French. We will also be learning how to say 'I like' and 'I dislike' a particular fruit in a sentence.



Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at suitable passwords and how to choose suitable passwords to protect ourselves online. In this unit, we will also look at how to type for speed improving our accuracy when doing this.



PE


In P.E, we will be playing football. Here we will look effective attacking and defending tactics which will be put into game-like scenarios.

Create a fact file of the Industrial Revolution in Blackburn containing: facts and information as well as images/drawings of buildings that were once used.



Can you draw more than one elevation of your house e.g. the front and the back with appropriate shading.




Design some packaging for your own torch, this should include what is in the box and a window to see the product. Can you write instructions on how to make your torch?
